

## High Power Rifle and BPCR Spring Work Day

**When:** March 11 at 8:00am to noon.....or as long as you can manage.

**Where:** Meet at the North Range Club House

**Who:** All across the course, F-class, and BPCR shooters are encouraged to participate

**Why:** To have our facilities repaired, ready, and organized for a season of competition

**What to bring:** Gloves, shovel, water, ear and eye protection. We will contact specific people about a nail gun/compressor, weed whacker, leaf blower, saws, generator, and construction materials.

### Projects by Priority:

Target Frame Repair and Re-Facing: Need a group of at least 6 people. We need to check and repair/replace all the wood target frames. New backing material added and new faces applied. Mark new scoring locations for application of VELCRO scoring disks. Need to end up with 10 small and 10 large frames: Need Nylon cord, wood, backing material, contact cement, target paste, wood screws, nails.

Target Frame Posts: Need 1 person to repair/replace the wooden posts. Need enough for 10 targets. Materials needed are wood and nails.

Screen and Yellow facing board: 2 people to repair/replace damaged screen sections. Paint board yellow. Need wood, yellow paint, and a brush.

Target Carrier Cables: Dusty will do this. Replace the damaged cables and level the carriers. Need cable

Convert scoring disks and targets to Velcro: Need 2 people on targets and 1 converting the markers. Convert scoring disks to Velcro. Add Velcro to the new scoring positions on the targets. Need Velcro and a plan.

Organize the Shed: Dusty will do with one other person. Empty and clean the shed. Organize and label the supply cans

Clear dirt away from targets 8,9,10: Need 2 people. Remove the dirt that has eroded into the pit area. Clean out the leaves and other winter debris from the pits. Need shovels, brooms, and leaf blower.

Bullet Stop Sand: Time permitting we can toss a few shovels full of dirt uphill into the impact area.
