SRC Board Meeting Notes -

Larry Bassett reported that all the work on the Long Range Firing lines has been completed and came in \$2300 under budget.

Jerry Masgai said that he had completed all the construction drawings for the Trap Range construction. Once these have been reviewed by the Trap Range Committee, bids from three contactors need to be obtained. Everyone is hopeful that construction should be completed during the month of July.

Mike Furrer introduced Jeff Upham who is one of the dads of the Junior Team. Jeff talked to us about the fantastic efforts and successes of three of our Junior Team members, Amanda Furrer, Rene Hopkins and Denise Martin specifically.

They had competed in the US Junior Olympics, National Championships Air Rifle and Small Bore Rifle at the Olympic Training Center in Colorado Springs, Colorado between April 8th thru April 12th. In Small Bore, Amanda finished 1st and tied the current National Record. This first place spot makes her the current US Junior Women's Small Bore National Champion. Denise Martin finished 2nd in her age group and Rene 46th overall.

In Air Rifle, Denise finished 3rd overall, Amanda 14th and Rene 108th.

As you can see, these Juniors are representing both themselves and our club in both local and national competition with fantastic results. Now, they need our help. The SRC Junior Team is looking for sponsors and donations to help them continue their training and competition. SRC can assist, but only to a point, after that additional funds are required for equipment, travel and lodging expenses. Muzzleloaders - During winter hours (standard time) range use is: Trap range 0900 - 1030; pistol range 1000 - 1200; 100 yd range 1000 -1600. Ranges will be vacated if matches are completed sooner. During daylight saving hours use of the ranges is: Trap Range 1000 - 1100; pistol range 1100 - 1300; 100 yd range 1000 - 1500.
