The work on the trap house and trap field layouts are progressing and bids are expected to be ready by our next board meeting in June. The Club is reconfiguring the trap fields and in so doing will be reducing the number of trap houses from three to two. The new trap houses will be easier to enter, have more room for storage and easier to maintain. Also included will be new updated wiring for the trap houses and new repositioned concrete approaches. Once approved, construction is expected to take approximately six weeks.

Bob Winnick, who was filling in for the Indoor Range chairman, told us that the Indoor Range Bullseye Event had twelve shooters and went very well. The Action Pistol event, scheduled for 5/18/2010 has been filled with twenty-five (25) participants signed up. On the down side, the Indoor Range Wednesday night shoot has been cancelled due to lack of participation. He also told us that the Woman's Handgun Shooting Group ends 5/18/2010 and due to the interest they will post a start date for the new class coming up.
